Recognized by the National Trust for Historic Preservation, the Liberty Theater recently underwent an \$8 million renovation. Operating today as a Performing Arts Center, Concert Hall, Conference Center, Town Hall Meeting venue and an elegant site for Weddings. The theater is perfect for large weddings and the McTavish Reception Room is wonderful for smaller weddings, receptions and rehearsal dinners. Capacity

- Theatre seats 667 plus 10 wheelchairs
- The McTavish Reception room can accommodate up to 185 persons at a sit down dinner configuration (60" rounds); more when bistro tables are used & one or more of the lobbies are incorporated.
